ACT UP – AN ONGOING PROJECT CANBERRA THEATRE CENTRE

Dear Parents/Carers,

ACT UP! 2024 is a Canberra based project that supports students' performance development skills. It provides the opportunity for secondary students to experience working in one of Australia's peak theatre venues and to be mentored by Canberra Theatre professionals. By connecting with a professional space, students and teachers can expand their theatre making skills as well as celebrate student achievements as a community.

Your child has been invited to participate in this project, with various in-school workshops culminating in a full day workshop and performance at the Canberra Theatre Centre (CTC) on 31 May.

For our Performers (Year 12 drama students)- there will be two in-school workshops with visiting CTC Teaching Artists (Session 1-during week 10/11 in Term 1, Session 2-during week 1/2 in Term 2-dates TBA). For our Stage Managers - there will be a full day workshop to be held at CTC on Monday 6 May, from 9 to 3pm (transport to be provided by family).

For Performers and Stage Managers- there will be an in-school visit from CTC (During week 4 in Term 2-date TBA).

For Performers and Stage Managers- all attend the full day workshop at CTC on 31 May, from 8.30am until final Showcase presented that evening, concluding at 10pm (Week 5 in Term 2).

If parents wish to see their child's performance, tickets for the festival must be purchased through the Canberra Theatre Centre. You will be advised closer to the date if your child is performing during the afternoon or evening sessions.
